	are even	better! I could not believe that it even worked with gluten-free flour so I can only now good it is the original way!
-	1/2	cup butter or margarine
	3/4	cup white sugar
	3	eggs
	1	tsp vanilla
	2	cups all purpose flour*
	1	tsp baking powder

* I used 1 cup of my gluten-free AP flour and 1 cup GF bread flour plus 1 tsp xanthan gum

Sift or stir together flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt, then beat into with butter

Prepare filling in a separate bowl by mixing pumpkin, brown sugar, cinnamon, salt, mace,

For the topping mix melted butter with brown sugar, cinnamon and pecans and set aside. Pour a little more than half the batter into a greased 9 x 13 inch pan then spread pumpkin filling evenly over all. Spoon remaining batter as evenly as you can over the filling. Do not worry that there are spaces between the batter but get it as even as possible and sprinkle

Bake for 50 - 60 minutes at 325°F or until cake springs back when lightly touched, a tester comes out clean and cake is pulling away from the sides of the pan. Cool before

For the cake beat butter and sugar until light, then beat in eggs one at a time.
